Course Reminders:

- No Sunflower Seeds
- Fill Divots with Sand and Seed
- Return empty sand/seed bottles to racks on #1/#11
- Repair Ball marks

Maintenance:

- Pruning of trees on holes 2,3,4

Winter Reminders:

- Sand and Seed is still important as the bluegrass seed will germinate in the spring
- Ballmarks may not heal in the winter but fixing them keeps the putting surface smooth
