## Turfgrass Maintenance Team

The maintenance crew will be aerifying greens April 13th (new) and April 15th (old), we will be using small coring tines that should require less healing time. The board has approved removal of the tree in the middle of the sand trap on hole 18. We have added a small sand and seed bottle station on #5 Tee, for when you forget to grab sand on #1. Also, we have added extra fertilizer bottles along the fairways on the back nine. We need your help keeping our golf course looking its best, please place trash and cigarette butts in the trash.
