We have added a small sand and seed bottle station on #5 Tee, for when you forget to grab sand on #1. Also, we have added extra sand and seed bottles along the fairways on the back nine. You may have noticed that some of the sand and seed is green and some is not colored. This is to differentiate the types of seed in the bottles and where they are to be used. The green sand is for tees only, the non colored sand is for fairways and rough. **We need your help keeping our golf course looking its best, please place trash and cigarette butts in the trash.**
